Raw Program – New Views in Main Window

Two new views in the Raw Main Window:

1. Receiver – view the tests performed on the incoming milk tanker.
2. CIP – view the CIP information.

Raw Program – Utilizing Bar Codes

Manifest Bar Codes:

If the manifest has a bar code identifying the manifest number (sometimes found on the bottom right hand corner) you can scan when entering data in the “Tag #” field.



Producer Bar Codes:

If the producer(s) on the manifest are identified with individual bar codes you can scan when entering data in the “Producer” field. In the example below, the producer bar code has additional information. The producer number is 2222-1 (tank 1).



Raw Program –New Defaults

Producer Defaults:

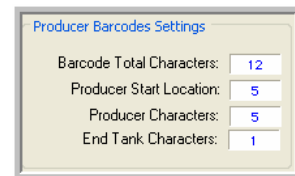
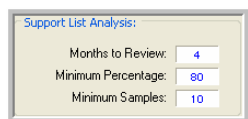
In the Raw Support List>Route tab, you can now enter producer(s) that are typically on that specific route.



To account for the additional information, set the defaults to read only the producer number: Go to Raw Program Menu>Raw Defaults>Raw Data Entry Defaults>Enter bar code characters. For the above example, the character setting would be:

Set Criteria of Finding Producers:

Go to Raw Program Menu>Raw Defaults>Raw Data Entry Defaults>> Set Route criteria to find producers. See below for Standard Criteria.



Producer – BTU Numbers Defaults:

In Raw Support Lists>Producer tab>set BTU for each producer.
