

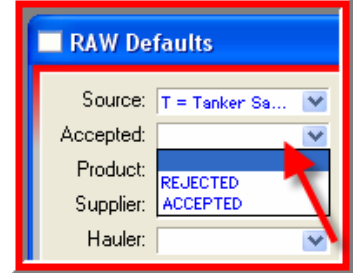

Raw Program – Accepted Tankers

Release and Accept or Reject Tankers:

- In the Raw Program menu > Raw Defaults > Data Entry Defaults > Accepted field > you have the option of choosing a blank space. Choosing this option would leave the Accepted / Rejected field blank until the route is **officially** accepted or rejected.

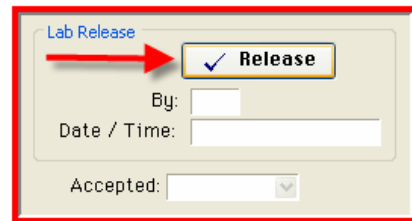
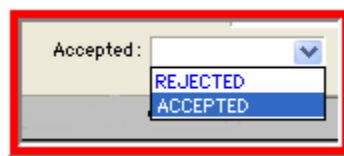
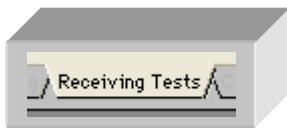


- Click Edit, choose the blank line in the Accepted field then click OK. Alternative is to right click and choose Clear. Then click OK.

- Now when in the ADD mode in the main Raw window the Accepted / Rejected will have to be selected corresponding to the outcome of the tanker quality checks performed.

- This will also leave the Accepted field blank when adding the samples through the Sample Schedule feature.
- After the tanker has been checked and accepted you can either; EDIT and select “ACCEPTED” or if using the **large** Raw main window you can click EDIT and click the RELEASE button. A small box will pop up requesting your initials. Enter your initials and then the tanker will be officially accepted with the date and time auto-filling to the current date and time.



- If you use the large Raw window RELEASE button you will have information on when the tanker was released, ready to unload and who released the load.



- If a tanker doesn't pass your incoming quality tests you can enter REJECTED, and have a record of the tankers that were rejected at your facility.
- It is your option to enter in either a blank or accepted or rejected into defaults.
